#### Group Leaders:

#### Garbage pick-up:

- Garbage & Recycling bags can be left beside existing garbage cans within the park and/or set aside by the entrance into the Park.

#### Elements of risk

- avoid picking up any sharps or large items. Sharps are defined as needles, syringes, blades, broken glass and any other items that could cause a cut or puncture. Large items include those that are heavy, bulky, difficult to grasp or unstable.
- potential risks in natural areas – be aware of your surroundings, exposure to plants such as poison ivy, stinging insects, branch or tree failure etc.

#### What to wear for safety (personal protective equipment)

##### All participants shall wear:

- closed toe proper footwear
- clothing appropriate for outdoor weather.
- wear gloves (provided)
- Stay a safe distance from roadway traffic and wear clothes that make you visible to traffic
- Ensure that participating children are well supervised

Please do not attempt to clean or lift any items you are unsure of!

If you encounter items that are unsafe or difficult to move, please leave it in place and contact the City of Sarnia Parks & Recreation Department.
